



Takenouchi-Hangan-Ryu-Matsuno-Crandall Iaido Style and Batto-do Instructional DVD

Takenouchi-Hangan-Ryu-Matsuno-Crandall is a 300-year old iaido style. The late Headmaster Tsuneyoshi Matunso designated Clifford C. Crandall, Jr. as his successor in a “passing of the sword” ceremony in Kobe, Japan in 2002. This included the presentation of an official certificate which hangs in our main location.

Headmaster Matsuno directed Headmaster Crandall to add his name to the style and school’s name, which is reflected in this certificate. The ceremony was filmed for a documentary which aired throughout Central New York in 2002, and a copy is available at our main location for students to view.

This three-hour, two DVD set visually documents the movements of the many forms for this style and includes the style’s history, ceremonial processes, uniforms, swords and sword cleaning, and numerous other aspects of the style.
